## Treasurer's Notes on 2022 End of Year & 2023 Year to Date Income/Expense Report:

- As planned, an "assessment holiday" was implemented in 2022, so no assessment income was received in 2022. Assessments at \$4/member were renewed in January 2023, and all WQM Meetings have contributed their full amounts.
- With only minor expenses from our initial blended gathering in 2022, our primary expense was two donations to Ecumenical Ministries of Oregon of \$450 each (a "make-up" donation for 2021 and our regular 2022 one). Our bank initiated a monthly service charge of \$8 in June 2021, which was increased to \$9 in February of this year.
- Our reserves, although quite low at the time of this report due to payment of camp deposits for this spring's gathering, will be replenished by the larger than expected registration fees. We anticipate receiving around \$6300 in "pay as led" donations, and incurring an additional \$1500 in camp fees and program expenses. We had budgeted a \$4000 subsidy for this gathering in our last budget, and it appears that likely only about a \$2500 subsidy may be needed.
